and professionalism. It's been a bit of a learning curve because working at a pregnancy center is a job like none other - but she has shown herself to be equal to the task.





NEW POST-ABORTION WELLNESS PROGRAM LAUNCHES

Did you know approximately 40% of women in abortion recovery programs suffer intense post-abortion syndrome symptoms? These can vary from intense guilt, to numbing emotions, to relational issues - even suicidal thoughts.

And with 125,000 abortions happening globally each day, that's a lot of hurting women.

Locally in our region, we have a new post-abortion wellness program in partnership with the Chequamegon Pregnancy Center called Transforming Grace.

Led by Pamela Peterson and Cherylann Hart, this program seeks to help women move from the stress and hurt of a past abortion into deeper healing and wellness - and into true freedom.

The program is a sevenweek course led by Pamela and Cherylann - both of whom have experienced the personal affects of an abortion. This program is transformational, and they're really looking forward to helping women in our communities.
