



## BUILD LIFE 2021 JOIN OUR CAPITAL CAMPAIGN EFFORTS

Breath of Life and the Chequamegon Pregnancy Center continue to impact women in our communities who may find themselves in an unwanted or unplanned pregnancy.

And the need is great. We continue to grow, and have been blessed immensely with the new location on Main Street in Ashland.

Build Life 2021 is our capital campaign to raise funds to pay off the mortgage of this building - thus ensuring 100% of all funds can go towards our ultrasound operations, pregnancy testing supplies, education parenting courses, center operations, remodeling, and more.

With the goal of raising \$250,000, we have already received over \$70,000 in financial support, with several churches and groups agreeing to match their congregation's specific donations.

Every cent of your donation will go towards purchasing this incredible location - making certain all future funds will go directly to impacting women and their unborn children.


Paying off the mortgage sooner will free us to focus future funds and efforts on saving more babies in our region.
