Anika Anderson is a local to the area and brings 11 years of ministry experience to the center. She worked in Portugal for the Word of Life ministry, reaching youth for the Gospel of Christ, facilitating leadership development, and partnering with local churches.



Hi! I'm Anika. I grew up in the Ashland area, then moved away for 12 years as I served the Lord in various ways and in many international locations. Though it was outside of my plan, God deemed it time for me to come home to Ashland. It was time to invest in my family and serve my community here.

I moved from Portugal, after serving there for four years, to Ashland in 2021. I got a job, started putting down roots, decided on a home church, and asked the Lord for open doors to serve.

A year after being home I wrote in my journal "...I can quit my job [as the manager of an event center] when God tells me to [with no other job lined up or any idea of what is next] because I know that He will care for me and lead me into the next chapter..." - I stepped out in faith and trusted God when it didn't make sense, and when God made it clear I needed to quit, I did.

Six days later I got a call about the opening here at the center. 18 days later I was offered the job as the Executive Director. God is so good.

I have been passionate about crisis pregnancy centers and foster care for the last 10 years. But never in my wildest dreams did I think God would be preparing me to serve my community in this way and in this position. I am so humbled to be here, and I look forward to watching as God uses His people to make an eternal impact on our community. Together as one body, let's take a stand for the gospel, work to save the unborn, and restore God's design for family.

A NEW MEN'S MINISTRY


at the center

As coaches, and people who care about those who hurt, we often say we lose those with needs through the cracks. One of the people we often lose is the young man who finds himself in an unexpected pregnancy.

Over several decades it's been my passion to see other men rise up to meet the challenge to help these young men. But the challenges are great since they're up against many barriers to keep them from finding help in their situation.

It seems our society has branded the pro-life issue as only pertaining to women, but the father of the child plays such a pivotal role in helping a woman choose life. But oftentimes, men are left out of the picture - even historically with pregnancy centers. But it's time to bring men into the conversation - encouraging them to be great fathers and helping them along the way.



It's been my experience seeing pregnancy resource centers change as they begin to minister to the needs of these fathers. In helping them, they in turn encourage their partners to carry their babies to full term. Ministries to men have changed the face of the pregnancy center to recognize that healing must take place for both the father and mother of the unborn child.

It's my hope, prayer, and desire to see men come alongside the Chequamegon Pregnancy Center and find an opportunity to meet the needs of these young men. In the last few weeks, we have seen God move in amazing ways:

- We had 62 total client appointments including six pregnancy tests (four positives).
- 35 lessons given, covering pregnancy education to basic life skills.
- One doctor referred their patient to us for support.
- Six gospel presentations.
- Two abortion-minded women after seeing the baby on the ultrasound, changed their minds to carry.
- One woman was so overwhelmed with life that she was planning to abort. After one session of coaching and seeing how obstacles can be moved and being presented with options and support, she changed her mind to carry.
- Our first volunteer orientation took place on December 6, and 19 people showed up!
- One pregnant high schooler is getting two credits toward graduation through our parenting course.


